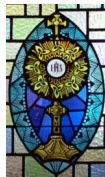
### **PARISH LENTEN CHARITY BRING LIFE TO LENT**

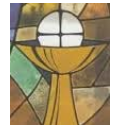

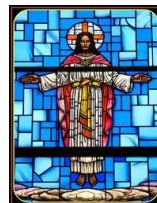
